



ASSISTANCE WITH FILING FOR UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE



Methods of Applying

The California Employment Development Department (EDD) has provided guidance on the best way to apply (“file a claim”) for unemployment insurance (UI) benefits.

- (1) The recommended method to apply for UI benefits is through [EDD’s UI Online website](#).
 - If you do not have a computer, EDD recommends that you use a smart phone to access the website, which is mobile friendly.

- (2) If filing online by computer or smart phone is not possible, you can apply for UI by phone.
 - An operator will assist in processing the UI application over the phone.

- (3) If neither of the above methods of applying for UI are possible, you may file a paper application.
 - Paper applications can be obtained by printing up the application provided on [EDD's Filing website](#).

By Fax or Mail

File your UI claim by accessing the paper Unemployment Insurance Application. For faster and secure processing, fax the completed application to the number listed on the form. If you mail your application, use the address on the form and allow additional time for processing.

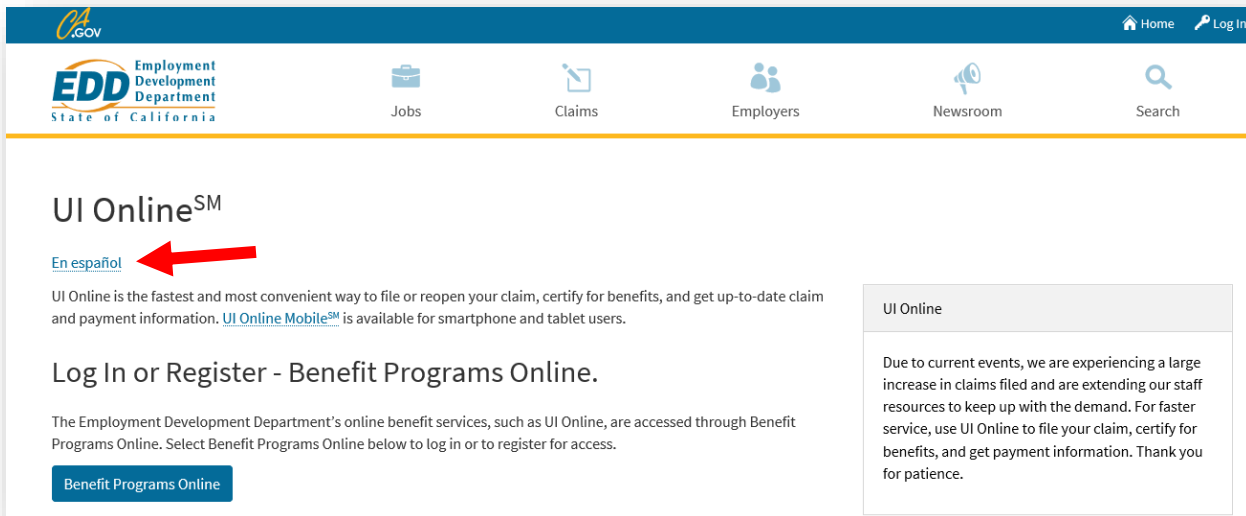
