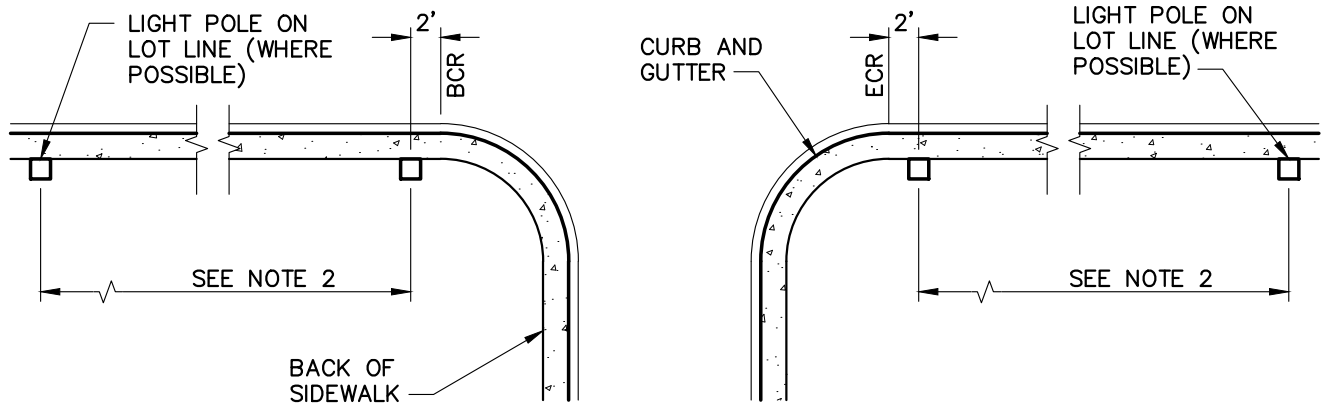


"T" INTERSECTION



REGULAR INTERSECTION

NOTES:

1. NONRESIDENTIAL AREAS ARE GENERALLY DEFINED AS STREETS NOT IN RESIDENTIAL AREAS. THESE ARE GENERALLY IN COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL AREAS AND SHALL INCLUDE ALL STREETS OF MORE THAN ONE LANE IN EACH DIRECTION (WHETHER RESIDENTIAL OR NOT).
2. STREET LIGHTS SHALL BE PLACED AT ALL MID-BLOCKS, DRIVEWAYS, INTERSECTIONS, END OF CUL-DE-SACS, AND SPACING SHALL NOT EXCEED 300 FT.
3. LIGHTS SHALL BE STAGGERED ON BOTH SIDES OF THE STREET.
4. LIGHTS SHALL BE PLACED ON LOT LINES WHERE POSSIBLE.
5. #3.5 PULL BOXES ARE REQUIRED BETWEEN LIGHT POLES WHENEVER THERE IS MORE THAN 300' BETWEEN POLES, AND ALSO WHERE A CONDUIT RUN CHANGES DIRECTION OR CROSSES A STREET.
