
## NOTE:

IN GENERAL, A STORM WATER POLLUTION PREVENTION PLAN (SWPPP) ADDRESSES HOW STORM WATER RUNOFF FROM A CONSTRUCTION SITE WILL BE REGULATED AND IS RÉQUIRED FOR PROJECTS OF ONE (1) ACRE OR GREATER. THE SWPPP, AND CORRESPONDING WASTE DISCHARGE IDENTIFICATION NUMBER (WDID#), ARE REQUIRED OF LANDOWNERS PRIOR TO THE ISSUANCE OF A GRADING PERMIT OR BEGINNING OF CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES. THE STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD (SWRCB) OVERSEES THE REQUIREMENTS FOR A SWPPP AND ISSUES THE WDID NUMBER. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION IS AVAILABLE AT THEIR WEB SITE: HTTP://WWW.SWRCB.CA.GOV/.

AS A CONDITION OF ISSUING A GRADING PERMIT, OR OTHERWISE ALLOWING CONSTRUCTION TO BEGIN ON A PROJECT, THE CITY OF INDIO REQUIRES THAT THE LANDOWNER OBTAIN A WDID NUMBER FOR THE PROJECT AND SUBMIT THREE (3) COPIES OF THE COMPLETED, AND SIGNED, SWPPP, TO THE CITY. THE CITY OF INDIO DOES NOT PLAN CHECK THE SWPPP, AND AS MENTIONED ABOVE, DOES NOT ISSUE THE WDID NUMBER. A NEW WDID NUMBER IS REQUIRED FOR EACH SPECIFIC PROJECT, AND A NEW WDID NUMBER IS REQUIRED IF THERE IS A CHANGE OF OWNERSHIP OF THE PROJECT SITE.
