RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF INDIO, CALIFORNIA, ADOPTING A FEE FOR SHORT TERM VACATION RENTAL PERMITS

- **WHEREAS,** on February 15, 2012, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 1607 which adopted a short term vacation rental ordinance;
- WHEREAS, it is determined necessary to adopt a new application fee for the review and processing of a short term vacation rental permit to aid in recovering costs incurred by the City in processing such applications;
- WHEREAS, City staff prepared a analysis to determine the City's cost of providing services for which the short term vacation rental permit application fee is charged, which analysis is part of the staff report for this item;
- WHEREAS, California Government Code Section 66000 et seq. authorizes the City to adopt fees for municipal services, provided such fees do not exceed the estimated reasonable cost to the City for providing the services; and
- WHEREAS, on March 7, 2012, the City Council conducted a duly noticed public hearing concerning the proposed short term rental permit application fee.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF INDIO DOES HEREBY FIND, DETERMINE, RESOLVE AND DIRECT AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. The recitals above are true and correct and are hereby incorporated by this reference.
- Section 2. All requirements of Government Code Section 66018 is hereby found to have been satisfied.
- Section 3. The City Council hereby finds that the short term vacation rental permit application fee does not exceed the cost to the City for providing the services to which the fee applies.
- Section 4. The City Council establishes the short term vacation rental permit application fee at \$30.00.
 - Section 5. This Resolution shall be effective upon adoption.
 - Section 6. The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this Resolution.
