

Turf Conversion Rebate

Get Rid of Grass

Turf removal is the most efficient and cost-effective way to quickly reduce water demand and extend our precious groundwater. This also helps eliminate nuisance water, overspray and run-off extending the life of adjacent hardscape.

Approved conversions receive **\$3 per square foot of grass removed up to a maximum of 50,000 square feet, which equates to a maximum of \$150,000.** Retrofits larger than 2,500 square feet are subject to additional landscape requirements and review by IWA and the City of Indio Community Development Department. Artificial turf is not a reimbursable expense.

Irrigation Upgrade Rebate

Boost Your Irrigation Efficiency

Customers with **above-ground upgrades** (smart nozzles, drip irrigation, pressure compensating bubblers, smart irrigation controller, pressure regulator etc.) can get up to **\$1,500** per account. Itemized receipts are required at completion of project to determine the eligible rebate amount. Please note that labor cost is ineligible for rebate. IWA does not provide a specific list of eligible brands or products.

Turf Conversion Requirements

Plant Coverage: Submit a landscape plan for all areas to be converted, include a minimum of 20% desert friendly plant coverage at plant maturity. The landscape plan/sketch will include: approximate square footage; plant list and quantities; plant locations; trees and shrubs on a separate zone; and valve locations.

Efficient Irrigation: Planting beds must utilize a drip irrigation system equipped with a pressure regulator and filter. Drip irrigation systems may incorporate subsurface/in-line drip tubing and non-adjustable, pressure compensating bubblers and emitters. Hand watering, adjustable bubblers and adjustable emitters are not allowed.

Surface Treatments: The modified area must be covered with a 2-3" layer of ground cover permeable to air and water. Common materials include rock, bark, ungrouted flagstone or pavers manufactured to be permeable. Artificial turf, concrete, and/or other impermeable treatments do not qualify. If a weed barrier is used, it must be manufactured to be permeable to air and water.

Requirement to Sustain the Upgrade: Areas converted through the rebate program cannot be replaced with turf in the future without prior written approval from Indio Water Authority. You may be required to refund some or the entire rebate if this requirement is violated.

Terms and Conditions

Eligibility: Properties must use water from Indio Water Authority (IWA) and the account(s) must be in good standing. The project area must have existing turf to be removed. Plants and other required elements installed outside of the project area will not count towards the program requirements. Artificial turf is not a reimbursable expense.

Pre-Inspection: To be eligible for the turf removal rebate program, applicants must NOT remove their existing turf until IWA completes a pre-inspection and you receive a "Letter to Proceed".

Projects started prior to receiving a pre-inspection and a "Letter to Proceed" will become ineligible for a rebate.

Final Inspection: Applicant must notify IWA after project completion, to schedule an inspection and verify program compliance. If the upgrade reveals any serious irrigation inefficiencies, you will be allowed 30 days to fully comply with the program conditions or forfeit your rebate. Projects not completed within 3 months of approval may become ineligible for rebate.

Other Applicant Responsibilities: Quality of work and appearance of the converted area are the responsibility of the participant.

IRS Form W-9: Complete and sign an Internal Revenue Service (IRS) Form W-9. Rebates may be considered as taxable income. IWA will issue a rebate check after all program conditions are met.

CITY/SCHOOL/ GOVERNMENT OUTDOOR REBATES

STEPS

- Email, drop-off or mail the application with documentation (checklist on other side) to IWA
- DO NOT REMOVE TURF BEFORE IWA APPROVAL (allow up to 30 days for review). Projects started prior to pre-inspection clearance from IWA are ineligible for rebates.
- Complete project within 90 days of receiving IWA approval (pre-inspection clearance)
- Call (442) 400-5205 to schedule a post-conversion inspection (irrigation upgrade receipts required)
- You can expect your check in 6-8 weeks of receiving your post-inspection clearance letter
